

# COVID-19 GUIDELINES

## DELPHI OPERA HOUSE

We are highly recommending masks be worn while attending all events and performances at Delphi Opera House. For the safety of patrons and staff please wear a mask when entering the theater.

Delphi Opera House has taken many measures to make our facility as safe as possible for you to come back and enjoy live entertainment.

- Sanitizing solution provided throughout the facility is safe for the general public.
- We have modern HVAC/ventilation systems that continually exchange outside air.
- We are following federal, state, and local guidelines. There are currently no restrictions for the 2022 season.
- Bathrooms will be open on 1st and 3rd floors to cut down on lines.
- The lobby will be open one hour before each performance.
- Masks are recommended to be worn by all patrons 9 and older.
- Concessions will be available at all performances.
- If sudden changes to our season happen, we will notify all ticket holders via email, social media, or phone.
- A FULL 2022 season is planned at this time with no attendance restrictions from the State of Indiana. We will continue to monitor the state and local cases and work with the Carroll County Health Department to keep everyone as safe as possible.

## COVID POLICY:

With our current COVID-19 cases in Carroll County and surrounding counties, we are highly recommending masks be worn while attending all performances and events. We ask for the safety of patrons and staff, please wear a mask when entering the theatre.
