

Delphi Opera House Art Enrichment Program for Youth – Fall Session 2023 Classes

The Delphi Opera House Art Enrichment Program is continuing this fall with two half-day workshops. These classes are FREE for all ages and grades K-12!!

Fall Art Enrichment Classes – Saturday, Oct 7th and Saturday Nov 4th, 9:15 – 11:45 am

Each date we will offer three classes. Students may sign up for one class per date and may attend either date or both. Parents are invited to come back at 11:30 to join their child(ren) and find out what they learned. Registration will be open until classes are full. Oct 7th: Cheer Clinic, Grades 3-6, ages 8-11, for up to 20 students.

Alisha Kuckartz, former Purdue Golden Girl and owner and lead teacher at Turning Pointe Academy in West Lafayette, will be teaching this fun, high-energy class that will focus on fundamental pom/cheer motions, jumps, and basic dance technique.

Oct 7th: Introduction to Theatre: Exploring Characters through Movement,

Grades 6-8, ages 11-13, for up to 20 students. Rebekah Runner, Theatre Instructor at Faith Christian in Lafayette, has performed/directed 23 shows! This workshop will use theatre games, activities, and group work to teach students how to develop characters by how they move. Students will also learn the dance choreography to "I Won't Grow Up" from *Peter Pan Jr.*

Oct 7th: Drawing Animals, Grades 6-12, ages 11-18, for up to 20 students

Daniel Bradford, Delphi High School art teacher, will be teaching how to draw animals from shape to finish. All supplies provided.

Nov 4th: Instrument Petting Zoo, Grades K-12, ages 5-18, for up to 30 students

Band directors Jay Dennison and Bryce Styles will have an assortment of band instruments to try out and Parker Denny of Don's Guitars in Lafayette will have several varieties of guitars, including at least one electric guitar, as well as a banjo and a mandolin.

Nov 4th: Face Painting, Grades K-12, ages 5-18, for up to 20 students

Cesar Cervantes, local artist well known for murals, painted rocks, and face painting will be teaching the students how to be face painters. All supplies provided.

Nov 4th: Working with Ink, Grades 8-12, ages 14-18, for up to 20 students

Daniel Bradford, Delphi High School art teacher, will be teaching how to create art with black ink and brushes. All supplies provided.
