The Delphi Opera House Art Enrichment Program is continuing this summer with two sessions in June. These classes are FREE for all ages and grades K-12!!

An introductory journey through the theatre process - from auditions to opening night - gain experience on stage and behind-the-scenes! Passport to the World of Art, Grades K-5, ages 5-11, for up to 16 students
